### NAWA – MAIN GOALS

Promoting studies and research opportunities in Poland

Internationalizing higher education and science

### THE BEKKER PROGRAMME

The aim of the Programme is to support the international mobility of PhD students, scientists and academic teachers in pursuit of scientific excellence by enabling them to conduct their research in renowned foreign institutions around the world.

The Programme is open to PhD students and scientists representing all fields and disciplines of science as well as artistic disciplines. There are also no restrictions regarding countries where the Host Institutions are located.

Research fellowships (3 to 24 months) shall allow scientists to stay in recognized research centres and to implement the Projects together with eminent foreign scientists and scientific teams as well as establish long-term relationship with foreign scientific teams. For young scientists, the Bekker Programme will be also an opportunity for postdoctoral fellowships while for PhD students it can be the part of their education.

The Programme provides funding to cover scholarship holder's living expenses related to the stay in the foreign Host Center and the mobility allowance as well.



### THE ULAM PROGRAMME

The aim of the Ulam Programme is to increase the internationalisation of Polish institutions of science and higher education. The Programme will allow both recognised and promising scientists who hold at least a doctoral degree, to visit Poland in order to strengthen the scientific potential of Polish entities and to participate in their scientific activities, primarily research projects and didactics.

The Programme will allow to invite scientists regardless of their age, from all around the world and representing all fields of science, including Polish scientists working permanently abroad.

### Activities to be carried out during the Scholarship may include:

- conducting research and/or development work
- post-doctoral training
- obtaining materials for scientific work or publication
- conducting didactic classes at the Host institution.

The visits under the Project can last from 6 to 24 months. **The Programme provides** financing for a Scholarship that covers the Fellow's living allowance of PLN 10,000 a month, along with a mobility allowance.



### THE IWANOWSKA PROGRAMME

The objective of the Programme is to promote international mobility of doctoral students by enabling them to acquire scientific experience in foreign research and academic centres, establish international scientific cooperation and implement a part of their doctoral degree programme in foreign units.

### Applicants in the Programme may be natural persons who are either:

- Doctoral students,
- Persons employed in Polish universities or other persons who have the conferment procedure for a doctoral degree formally open,
- Persons who are in the "Industrial PhD" programme.

#### The Programme allows visits whose aim is to:

- 1) Implement a part of a doctoral degree programme;
- 2) Implement a part of the "Industrial PhD" programme, in accordance with the rules announced by the Minister of Science and Higher Education;
- 3) Conduct scientific research related to preparing a doctoral thesis;
- 4) Obtain materials for the doctoral thesis or scientific publication;

- 5) Conduct teaching activities at the host centre as a complement to the above objectives;
- 6) Other forms of scientific or academic activity related to preparing the doctoral thesis as a complement to the above aims.

In the application, the **Applicant submits** a project covering one or more of the above-mentioned activities that (s)he intends to implement at a foreign host centre, indicating its goals, relevance to the development of their academic career and justifying the host's choice for planned activities.

The Programme is open to candidates representing all fields of science. There are also no restrictions on the countries where host centres are located.



### THE NAWA CHAIR

#### **NAWA CHAIR**

The objective of the NAWA Chair programme is to support the highest quality scientific and research as well as didactic activities conducted by Polish academic and scientific units by including world-class foreign scientists in these activities.

The programme is addressed to selected institutions of the higher education and science system. They will be allowed to invite to Poland outstanding specialists from thematic priority areas, who will significantly develop breakthrough research, strengthen their teaching activities and support these institutions in preparing applications for prestigious grants.

Under the programme, it will be possible to employ scientists with outstanding international achievements from countries around the world for a period of 36-48 months, and create project groups for them.

The programme also offers an option of covering the costs of scientific research in the field of basic research (Research component) financed by the National Science Centre in Poland.

# Strategic Partnerships Programme

The objective of the Programme is to develop durable solutions in the area of scientific, implementation and teaching process cooperation, pursued within the framework of international academic partnerships.

The results of the project should provide a foundation for the development of a long-lasting cooperation of entities forming a Partnership. Projects implemented under the Programme shall be in line with a long-term development policy of an Applicant and Partners.

## Thematic scope of actions (selected) implemented under the Programme:

- drafting of publications with an international scope;
- elaboration and lodging of grant applications;
- organisation of international conferences, seminars;
- development or designing of new educational tools and methods;
- participation in internships;
- exchange of students and employees;
- support for reviewing processes in doctoral, post-doctoral and professorial procedures;
- carrying out research and development work with an international dimension.



# Welcome to Poland

The purpose of the project is to support the institutional capacity of Polish universities by increasing competencies of the academic staff and the institutions' potential to receive people from abroad, preparing places dedicated to serving students and foreign staff in organisational terms, and developing activities related to internationalisation at home. The key activity will also be shaping the attitudes of openness and tolerance in the academic and social environment of a university.

### Poland My First Choice Programme

The Poland My First Choice scholarship programme aims to encourage young talented people from the countries listed below to pursue studies at the best Polish HEIs.

The Programme offers an opportunity to pursue full-time second-cycle studies at public and private HEIs on all fields of study offered by institutions offering education at highest level subordinate to the Minister of Science and Higher Education, with a monthly NAWA scholarship amounting to PLN 2,000 (ca. EUR 460) to cover the living allowance during the period of education in Poland specified in the Regulations. In the case of public HEIs, the Programme also offers an exemption from education fees. The Programme provides the participants with an opportunity to study in Polish or in another language. The Applicants select HEIs and fields of study in which they want to enrol based on the educational offer of Polish higher education institutions and apply for the curriculum of their choice. Final decisions regarding admissions of Applicants and financial conditions of education shall be made by HEIs.
